## • RAFT RACE

(About 1 mile with no obstacles) *Build a raft and race it down the river Parrett in fancy dress (optional), fancy dress judged before racing starts. Judging will be in 2 classes, children and all others*

## HOUSTON LANDROVER

**CHALLENGE TROPHY** for 'King of the River', fastest time of the day. *Class cups presented by O.C.M.I.S. IRRIGATION LTD*

**THE YFC TROPHY** will be presented to the fastest raft in any class manned completely by YFC members.

## • BALE RACING

*Two teams run together but it's against the clock. Teams of 4. 1 person stands on the bale as it's rolled down the course which is a straight course with 180 degree turn at the end and then back to the starting position.*

### RACE 3 - MIXED

- Entry £4.00 - per team
- The person on the bale must be on the bale at all times, but different team members can take over. The other 3 people push and steer the bale. Fastest time wins.

## • RIVER IT'S A KNOCKOUT

*Teams of 4 race over numerous obstacles suspended over or in the river. Fastest time wins, but with time penalties if one or more members of the team don't complete an obstacle.*
